Inappropriate Dance Behavior

Everyone dancing should feel safe from unwanted attention and from comments and conduct of a sexual or harassing nature. However friendly and flirtatious the dance community may appear, sexual attention and comments are inappropriate when outside any dancer's comfort zone, and they are particularly unwelcome when coming from an older person to a younger person. If you are the recipient of a remark or behavior that makes you uncomfortable, you are encouraged to tell the person directly. "Please stop that" or "I don't like that" are examples of short and clear communication. If you are unable, for any reason, to resolve the situation on your own, tell someone in charge, like a dance manager or Board member. Even if you have resolved the situation, Board members would like to hear about the incident promptly to determine whether a pattern exists and additional action may be required.

If you are told to stop comments or behavior, or that your behavior is unwelcome, stop immediately and apologize.
