Tips for New Dancers

Welcome to North Bay Country Dancing! We are delighted to have new dancers join us. It can be disorienting to be the "new kid," so here are some helpful tips:

- Please make sure the shoes you'll be dancing in don't have any grit on the bottoms. We love our hall—help us take good care of the floor.
- Dance with people you don't know. You can ask anyone to dance, and dancing with lots of different partners is the best way to learn. We change partners after each dance.
- Listen to the caller. The caller is here to help us learn the dances and have a good time. If you have a question, ask the caller during the walk-through. You may not be the only person with that question.
- Mistakes happen. Let it go, smile, and remember you'll have plenty of chances to get it right.
- Washing your hands before the snack break can help to keep us all healthier.
- Your children are welcome members of our dance community, but please be responsible for supervising them. Not all dances are suitable for our smaller dancers. Ask the caller if you're unsure.
- If you like the music let the band know. Go ahead, make their day!

Besure you come again—dancing gets better every time—and practice makes perfect!
