Getting to Know You

Many of us have danced with people for years without knowing what they do in other parts of their life. Carpooling is a way to get to know your fellow dancers better and save money! Individually, some of us have set up carpools from different cities. Let's enlarge this practice to help all.

Here are some carpooling tips from Marlene, one of our seasoned coordinators:

- Always meet at the same place, such as a big hotel parking lot.
- Try to be prompt to get to dances on time, or call the organizer's cell if you need to cancel.
- Sending email notices out three days before the dance has worked well.
- Ask people to only email back if they ARE going, not to decline, which saves everybody time.
- If the email leader is not going, they send emails, but include that it will be a leaderless carpool and ask people to "reply all."
- Establish a policy of always contributing to the driver's costs.
- Take turns driving.
