We are fortunate to have legendary fiddler Frank Ferrel play for the January 9 San Rafael dance. Frank began fiddling at age 8, having inherited both his talent and interest from his grandfather, a traditional musician from Ohio and West Virginia. Frank played with Irish, French-Acadian and Canadian Maritime fiddlers in Boston in the 60's, a time when music greats were playing the local dance halls. Frank has since appeared on A Prairie Home Companion (and is included in their anthology recording "PHC Tourists"). He's performed with the legendary Celtic group The Boys of the Lough, has a CD in the Library of Congress's Select List of 25 Recordings of American Folk Music, and most recently played with acclaimed accordion player Joe Derrane. He's the music director of the NPR series Says You. Our own Charlie Hancock, on keyboard, will be appearing with Frank.
